

Head Scarf

Instructions are for Angora, changes for Supra Mohair are in parentheses.

MATERIALS: FLEISHER'S or BUCILLA IMPORTED ANGORA B. 3 balls. or BEAR BRAND, FLEISHER'S or BOTANY SUPRA MOHAIR, 1 ball.

KNITTING NEEDLES: 1 pair "Boye" Needles, Size 10—or SIZE YOU REQUIRE TO KNIT TO GAUGE GIVEN BELOW.

GAUGE: Angora — 4 sts = 1 inch Supra Mohair — 4 sts = 1 inch 11 rows = 2 inches5 rows = 1 inch

To learn how to check your gauge, see page 12 before starting to knit.

Cast on 3 sts for center of front edge of garter st border. Row 1—wrong side—Inc. 2 sts in each

of first 2 sts, k 1; 7 sts. Row 2—K 1, inc. 1 st in each of next

4 sts, k 2; 11 sts.

Row 3—K 6, place marker on needle for center seam, k 5. Slip marker every row.

Row 4—K 1, inc. 1 st in next st, k to

within 1 st of marker, inc. 1 st in each of next 2 sts, slipping marker, k to within 3 sts of end, inc. 1 st in next st. k 2: 15 sts.

Row 5—K 3 for garter st border on side edge, p to within 3 sts of end, k 3 for garter st. Repeat rows 4 and 5, 22 (20) times; repeat row 4 again; 107 (99) sts; 50 (46) rows from beg.—about 9 ins. measuring at center of one side edge up to center seam.

TIE STRINGS — With another piece of yarn, make a slip loop on same needle with the 107 (99) sts, using both ends of yarn, cast on 26 sts for tie string.

Next row—K these 26 sts: k to end for garter st border on back edge: cast or 26 sts on free needle with another end

needle with other sts; 159 (151) sts. Next row—K increasing 2 sts at center seam only; 161 (153) sts. K 1 row.

Bind off.
