

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

MOHAIR DRESS (Page 49)

SIZES: Directions are for Small (8-10). Changes for Medium (12-14) and Large (16) are in parentheses.

MATERIALS: Bernat Mohair Plus (A), 1½ oz. ball—19 (20, 21) balls. Bernat Meadowspun (B), 1 oz. skein—10 (12, 13) skeins. Nos. 8 and 9 knitting needles, OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GIVEN GAUGE.

GAUGE: A and B tog on No. 9 needle; 4 sts = 1".

NOTE: Entire dress is worked with 1 strand of A and B tog.

BACK: With No. 8 needle and A and B tog, cast on 101 (105, 109) sts. Work in k 1, p 1 ribbing for 1", increasing 1 st on last row—102 (106, 110) sts. Change to No. 9 needles. Work stock. st until 34" from beg, or desired length to underarm. SHAPE ARMHOLES: Place a marker at each end. Dec 1 st each end of next row, then every other row once more—98 (102, 106) sts. Work even until armhole measures 7½ (8, 8½)" from marker. SHAPE SHOULDERS: Bind off 10 (11, 12) sts beg next 2 rows, then 11 sts beg next 4 rows—34 (36, 38) sts. Place remaining sts on a holder.

FRONT: Work same as back.

SLEEVES: With No. 8 needles and A and B tog, cast on 60 (64, 68) sts. Work in k1, p 1 ribbing for 1". Change to No. 9 needles and stock. st. Work even until 15½" from beg, or desired length. Bind off.

POCKETS: Make 2. With No. 9 needles and A and B tog, cast on 25 sts. Work stock. st for 5½". Change to No. 8 needles and work in k 1, p 1 ribbing for 1". Bind off in ribbing.

COLLAR: Sew left shoulder seam. With No. 8 needles and A and B tog, k across sts from back and front neck holders, increasing 28 sts evenly across row—96 (100,104) sts. Work in k 1, p 1 ribbing for 7". Bind off loosely in ribbing.

FINISHING: Sew other shoulder and weave collar seam. Sew side seams to markers at underarm. Sew sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew on pockets as shown. Steam seams lightly on wrong side.
